



# CAMPING RULES

## Welcome to the 2026 WAO and KNHS!

We are guests of the beautiful Royal National Hippic Centre (KNHS). Our camping area is located on their outdoor equine competition fields.

We kindly ask you to respect the Camping Rules so that we keep the site happy, clean, and safe for everyone—and so that we are welcomed back in 2027.

- Please clean up after your dog!
- Please don't let your dog swim in the pond.
- Because there are horses staying on site, dogs are **NOT** allowed to be off leash except in the dog exercise area.
- Please only park in a pitch number assigned to you as per the plan and lists. If you park on the wrong number, you will have to move. Please make sure you are within your pitch boundary.
- You may swap pitches with other people from your country but both handlers must agree otherwise you must stick to the plan. This must be a like for like swap ie tents cannot move to non-tent areas, no electric cannot move to electric area and so on.
- In the caravan and motorhome area you may only have a awning type tent. This will be defined as attached to your caravan or motorhome and not used for sleeping.
- KNHS does not allow the use of carpet or plastic underneath your camper or awning.
- Please do not drive anywhere else on site, except in and out of the camping area.
- If you paid for an electrical hook-up, it has been assigned to your pitch number. Anyone who has not paid but plugs in will be asked to leave site and your country will be charged for 8 nights of electric.
- Generators may not be used before 8am or after 9pm. If there are any complaints about your generator, we reserve the right to stop you using it.
- Showers are located in the camping area (as per plan).
- Toilets are located in the camping area, in WA Hall, and in the restaurant (see site map).
- The toilets & showers will close at 9am on Monday 18th May.
- All campers and camping units must have left the venue by 10.30am on Monday 18th May.

# CAMPING NOTES

## 2026 WAO

- Pitches measure approx. 10m x 10m
- Red dots on the plan are pitches with electric.
- All pitches will have a cone designating the pitch number in one of the corners.
- For fire safety reasons, please park in the center of your pitch where possible.
- Please do not park on roadways at any time so emergency vehicle access is never compromised.
